She is an instrument of many inventions and researches in the institution. **She took the initiative to start a Spiritual Hostel for the upliftment of girls.** She invented the Rajyoga Shibir (a 3 days Rajyoga Camp) which is a very impressive medium for a new student to start with. She initiated mass meditation sessions in public programmes, teachers training courses for girls who want to dedicate themselves for world service, etc.

She has been an eloquent speaker in many national conferences, seminars, dialogues, retreats, etc. held at various places in India. And she has also travelled to the UK, USA, UAE and African countries with the Godly message.

She is a member of the planning committee of the Brahma Kumaris. She has been motivating thousands of youth through various campaigns and festivals nationwide. For her youth services, His Excellency the Governor of Gujarat, Shri Sundarsinghji Bhandari presented her the **"National Award for Excellence in youth through spiritual way" on Gujarat Day** i.e. 1st May, 2002.
