

# Conference Participation: FAQs & Guidelines

## General Eligibility & Participation

### **1. What is the focus of the conference, and when will it take place?**

The conference will focus on spiritual empowerment, values-based leadership, financial ethics, stress management, and personal development, all tailored specifically for finance professionals. It will take place from **5th to 9th November 2025**, concluding with sightseeing and departure on the final day. A detailed program schedule will be released soon.

### **2. Who is eligible to attend this conference?**

This conference is exclusively for members of the financial fraternity, including CAs, CSs, CMAs, MBAs, CFAs, CFOs, Bankers, Tax Practitioners, and officials from the GST and Income Tax departments.

### **3. Can retired finance professionals or students pursuing finance-related degrees participate?**

At present, practising professionals, working individuals, and retired professionals from the finance sector are eligible to participate. Students pursuing finance-related degrees may also register; however, their participation will be subject to seat availability and final confirmation.

### **4. Can I attend if I am over 70 years of age?**

Separate programs are planned for applicants above 70 years in the future. Currently, the accommodation is designed for those below 70.

### **5. Can my family members accompany me?**

Yes, your spouse and children aged 7 years and above are welcome to attend. **Kindly note that a separate registration form must be filled out for each accompanying family member.**

## Application, Approval & Assistance

### **1. Is registration automatic upon form submission?**

No. Submission of the form does not confirm your participation. Final confirmation will be communicated after verification by the organizing team.

**2. Can incorrect or incomplete information lead to rejection?**

Yes. Providing incorrect or incomplete details may result in the rejection or cancellation of your application.

**3. How will I know if my registration is confirmed?**

You will receive a confirmation message through email, SMS and WhatsApp from the organizing team after your application is reviewed and approved.

**4. Will I get a confirmation receipt or pass after approval?**

Yes. A confirmation message/email will be sent upon acceptance of your registration.

**5. When should I book my travel tickets?**

It's advisable to book travel only **after receiving confirmation of your participation.**

**6. Can I edit my form details after submission?**

No. In case of errors, you'll need to contact the helpline number **7986454542** to request corrections.

**7. What if I need to cancel my participation after confirmation?**

Kindly inform the organizers as early as possible at helpline number **7986454542** so that your place can be allotted to someone on the waiting list.

**8. Can I transfer my registration to someone else if I'm unable to attend?**

No. Registrations are **non-transferable**. If you're unable to attend, kindly inform the organizers.

**9. Who should I contact for registration assistance?**

For any queries or clarifications while filling out the form, you can contact helpline number **7986454542**.

**10. Can someone else fill the registration form on my behalf?**

Yes — provided they enter accurate, verified information and you have reviewed it before submission.

**11. What documents do I need to upload?**

You'll need to upload:


- A recent photograph

- Your visiting card (front and back)

**12. What file formats are accepted for photo and visiting card uploads?**

Only **image formats (JPG, JPEG, PNG)** are accepted.

**13. What should I do if I'm unable to upload my documents?**

Check your internet connection, compress your image file size, or reach out to  7986454542 for assistance.

**14. Is group registration possible?**

Yes, groups are welcome to participate. However, a separate registration form must be filled out for each individual member of the group. To indicate your group association, please mention the registration number of your group head in the '**Registration Number of head of Group**' section of the form.

**15. Can I invite my finance professional friend who didn't register?**

No. Only those with confirmed registrations will be allowed on campus due to accommodation and security protocols.

**16. Do I need to be a regular meditator or spiritual practitioner to attend?**

Not at all. The conference is open to all finance professionals, regardless of their spiritual background. Beginners are most welcome.

**17. Are there any VIP passes or reserved seating?**

All participants are treated equally and seated on a first-come, first-served basis during sessions, following the principle of simplicity and humility.

 **Children's Participation**

**1. Can I bring infants or children below 7 years?**

It is kindly recommended not to bring infants or children below 7 years for this event.

**2. Are there separate sessions for children?**

Yes. Children above 7 will have dedicated parallel sessions on **Life Skill Development** that include values-based games, workshops, and interactive learning.

**3. Can children attend main sessions with parents?**

Preferably no — parallel sessions are organized to engage them meaningfully, ensuring a distraction-free experience for adults.

## **Accommodation & Facilities**

### **1. What kind of accommodation will be provided?**

- Separate accommodation for males and females
- Shared rooms with other participants
- Accommodation is only provided from 4th November 2025 to 10th November 2025

### **2. Can spouse stay together?**

We kindly inform you that separate accommodation is arranged for males and females.

### **3. Can I request a single room for health or personal reasons?**

Single rooms are not guaranteed as accommodation is shared by default. You can mention any special need in the 'Any Other Information' field of the form. The organizers will try to accommodate genuine cases subject to availability.

### **4. Is separate senior citizen accommodation available?**

Not for this event. Applicants above 70 will be considered for future programs specifically for senior participants.

### **5. Can I join only for a day or part of the conference?**

The program is thoughtfully designed as a continuous 5-day spiritual and professional experience, so partial participation is generally not encouraged. However, in genuine and unavoidable cases, it may be considered with prior information and approval. We kindly request you to inform the team in advance if such a situation arises.

### **6. Can I book accommodation for additional days before or after the conference?**

Accommodation is arranged from 4th November to 10th November 2025, covering one day before and one day after the conference, which will be held from 5th to 9th November 2025. We kindly request you to plan your travel within these dates.

## **Travel, Transport & Tours**

### **1. Is there any suggested train or route to reach Abu Road?**

Participants may refer to commonly available trains to Abu Road (Rajasthan) from their cities. Popular connections include from Mumbai, Delhi, Ahmedabad, Jaipur. It's advised to book tickets early after receiving confirmation of participation.

**2. Will transport be provided from the airport?**

No. Transport facilities are arranged only from **Abu Road Railway Station** to the conference venue and back.

**3. What if I arrive at a different railway station or by road/private vehicle?**

Participants arriving by private vehicle or at a different station will need to arrange their own transport to the venue. Kindly inform the organizing team in advance for smooth coordination.

**4. What should I do if my train is delayed?**

Inform the helpline number **7986454542** immediately with your updated arrival time so transport arrangements can be adjusted.

**5. Will transport be provided to Abu Road Railway Station after the conference?**

Yes. Transport will be arranged for participants to reach Abu Road Railway Station on **9th & 10th November 2025** after the sightseeing visit.

**6. What sightseeing locations are planned?**

A guided visit to key attractions in **Mount Abu**, including Nakki Lake, the Dilwara Temple, and the headquarters of the Brahma Kumaris, will be organised on November 9, 2025.

**7. Can family members participate in sightseeing?**

Yes, if they're officially registered and staying at the conference accommodation.

**8. Can I skip sightseeing and leave earlier?**

Yes, but you need to inform the helpdesk in advance so that your drop-off can be arranged accordingly.

**9. Are there any recreational or sightseeing activities?**

Yes. A sightseeing tour is planned for 9th November 2025 before departure

**10. Can I bring a driver or attendant?**

No. The conference facilities, including accommodation and meals, are reserved only for registered finance professionals and their eligible family members (spouse and children above 7 years).

## Onsite Facilities & Campus Amenities

### 1. What amenities will be provided during the stay?

- Satvik meals (without onion and garlic)
- Accommodation
- Pick-up and drop transport between Abu Road Railway Station and the venue
- A godly gift

### 2. Will medical facilities be available?

A first-aid facility and doctor-on-call will be available for minor medical needs. Participants with specific health conditions should carry their own regular medicines.

### 3. Are laundry services available?

No. Participants are requested to carry sufficient clothing for the duration of the stay.

### 4. Will arrangements be made for participants with mobility issues?

Limited wheelchair access is available. Participants needing assistance should mention it in the form's remarks section or inform the organizers at least a week in advance.

### 5. In which language will sessions be conducted?

The sessions will primarily be conducted in **Hindi**. Translations in **English** may be available depending on audience composition.

## Conference Dining: Satvik Meals & Dietary Care

### 1. What type of food will be served?

Only **Satvik vegetarian meals** without onion and garlic will be served.

### 2. Are special dietary needs (e.g., vegan, gluten-free) accommodated?

You may indicate your requirements in the "Any Other Information" section, but complete customization cannot be guaranteed.

### 3. I am diabetic — will appropriate food options be available?

Yes — plain rice, dal, and lightly cooked vegetables without onion/garlic are typically available. However, you should carry your essential dietary supplements if needed.

## **Conference Norms & Etiquette**

### **1. Is there any dress code for the spiritual sessions?**

While no dress code is required, participants are encouraged to wear modest, comfortable, and light, simple, and sober colors are recommended in keeping with the spiritual and serene atmosphere. The weather in Abu will be cold, so participants should bring warm clothes like sweaters, shawls, and winter caps.

### **2. Is prior association with Brahma Kumaris mandatory?**

No, but you will need to declare your existing association (if any) in the form. As long as they belong to the finance fraternity and accept the guidelines, including the spiritual and substance-free environment.

### **3. Can I distribute my business cards to participants?**

Yes — but only during informal interactions. Soliciting clients or commercial promotions during sessions or inside campus is strictly discouraged.

### **4. Will my personal details shared in the form be kept confidential?**

Yes — participant details are used solely for the purpose of conference coordination and are not shared for any commercial or unrelated activities.

### **5. Can I leave the campus during the conference days?**

Participants are expected to remain on the campus for the duration of the conference to experience its full benefits.


### **6. Are mobile phones allowed during sessions?**

Phones should be kept on silent mode or switched off during sessions and meditation. Recording and photography are prohibited inside meditation halls.

### **7. What if I lose my belongings during the conference?**

A lost-and-found desk will be set up at the reception area. However, participants are responsible for the safety of their personal valuables.

### **8. Who should I contact in case of an emergency during the conference?**

You can immediately reach out to the **conference helpdesk** or call  **7986454542**.

9. Note: The entire conference campus is a pure, spiritual environment where smoking and alcohol are strictly prohibited.

## **Voluntary Contributions & Support Opportunities**

### **1. Is there a registration fee?**

No. All facilities are provided free of cost. However, voluntary and CSR contributions are welcome.

### **2. Are donations compulsory?**

No. Participation is entirely free. Voluntary donations and CSR contributions are optional and welcome.

### **3. Can I contribute voluntarily or offer CSR support?**

Yes. While participation is free, voluntary donations and CSR contributions are welcome. You can contact the organizers directly for details.

### **4. Can I volunteer for future finance programs?**

Absolutely. You can express your interest during the conference or contact your nearest Brahma Kumaris center.

## **Final Checklist & Arrival Instructions**

- Carry a valid photo ID, recent photograph, and visiting cards (digital copies ready).
- Bring modest, warm clothing, personal toiletries, medicines, a water bottle, notebook, and pen.
- Arrive at Abu Road Railway Station by 5th Nov 2025 and use the provided transport to the venue.
- Register at reception with your ID and confirmation details, then follow accommodation and schedule guidelines.
- Attend orientation and initial sessions as scheduled.
