Energy is one of the largest recurring operational requirements for community service institutions. By adopting solar power, Brahma Kumaris campuses can substantially reduce dependence on conventional electricity while directing greater financial resources towards education, value-based programmes, youth empowerment, health awareness and social development initiatives.

WHY THIS PROJECT MATTERS



Organic waste is not a burden-it is an untapped resource. Through scientific waste management and renewable energy generation, biodegradable waste can be converted into clean fuel, significantly reducing landfill disposal, greenhouse gas emissions, and dependence on fossil fuels.

The proposed project will establish a replicable model of integrated waste management that combines renewable energy, sustainable agriculture, resource conservation, and environmental education within a community campus setting.

By demonstrating practical sustainability solutions, the project will inspire thousands of visitors each year to adopt environmentally responsible lifestyles and contribute towards a cleaner, greener future.

Establish a modern community-scale Biogas & Organic Waste-to-Energy Plant for sustainable waste management.



Convert biodegradable kitchen waste and cow dung into clean, renewable cooking fuel.



Reduce dependence on LPG and other fossil fuels for community kitchen operations.



Minimise landfill disposal and harmful methane emissions through scientific waste processing.



Produce high-quality organic bio-slurry to support landscaping, gardens, and natural farming initiatives.



Develop a model zero-waste campus that demonstrates practical environmental stewardship and circular economy principles.

Demonstrate practical adoption of sustainable electric mobility in educational, spiritual and community institutions.

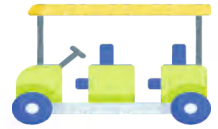

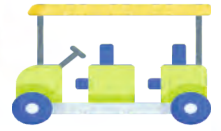
